2.00pm	<p>Haining Farm open for car parking via the farm entry off Don Road, refer to map.</p> <p>Please follow traffic management directions on Don Road and be aware of traffic safety as the farm entrance does not have good sight lines for turning vehicles.</p> <p>Park at the farm buildings and walk to the information marquee.</p>
2:30pm 3:00pm 3:30pm	<p>Join a guided walk to vantage points to overlook works that are currently underway to construct wetlands in the north-west of Haining Farm and gain an understanding of the habitat restoration and parkland opportunities.</p> <p><i>Note that there is no entry to the construction area which is currently fenced off for safety.</i></p>
4.00pm	<p>Wrap up discussion and close the farm to public access.</p>
